Applications are invited from eligible Citizens of India for filling up 10 posts against (8 for Level-1 & 2 for Level-2) Scouts & Guides Quota of North Western Railway for the year 2022-23. **The candidates having Scouts & Guides qualification can only apply.** The applications for Level-2 (Group 'C' Sixth P.C Pay Band 5200-20200+GP 1900/-) and Level-1 (erstwhile Group 'D' Sixth P.C Pay Band 5200-20200+GP 1800/-) posts, as given below are to be sent separately only by ordinary post (Courier post/Registered post/ speed post will not be accepted) to **Assistant Personnel Officer (Recruitment), Railway Recruitment Cell, North Western Railway, Power House Road, Opp. DRM Office, Jaipur – 302006** or dropped in the Application Box kept in the office of RRC, Jaipur upto 17.00 hrs. of the closing date i.e. 09.12.2022. For candidates residing in Assam, Meghalaya, Manipur, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Lahaul & Spiti Districts and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar and Lakshadweep islands and for candidates residing abroad, the closing date for receipt applications by Ordinary Post will be 24.12.2022 upto 17.00 hrs. **Applications received after closing date and time will not be entertained.**

1. Minimum Educational Qualification:

2. 2 Scouts and Guides Qualifications: (For level 2 and level 1 both)

- A President Scout/Guide/Rover/Ranger OR Himalayan Wood Badge (HWB) holder in any Section;
- Should have been an active member of a Scouts Organization for the last 5 (Five) years i.e. 2017-18 onwards. The "Certificate of Activeness" should be as per the Annexure-8 enclosed, and
- Should have attended two events at National Level OR All Indian Railways' level AND Two events at State level as per Annexure-9.

Note:- Marks will be given for additional certificates attached as per para 11 in the notification.

4. Extent of Age Relaxation

The upper age limit is relaxable as under:-

- 4.1 For Ex-Servicemen up to the extent of service rendered in Defence + 3 years, provided they have put in more than 6 months service after attestation.
- 4.2 By 10 years for UR persons with disabilities (PWD), 13 years for OBC Persons with Disabilities and 15 years for SC/ST Persons with Disabilities (PWD).
- 4.3 Upper age limit in case of widows, divorced women and women judicially separated from husband but not remarried shall be 35 years for Unreserved, 38 years for OBC and 40 years for SC/ST candidates.
- 4.4 For serving Group-C and erstwhile Group-D Railway Staff, Casual labour and substitutes in Railways who have put in minimum of 03 years service (continuous or in broken spells), the upper age limit will be up to 40 years for Unreserved candidates, 45 years for SC/ST candidates and 43 years for OBC candidates. For those working in Quasi-Administrative Offices of the railway organization such as Railway Canteens, Co-operative Societies and Institutions, the relaxation in upper age limit will be up to the length of service rendered subject to maximum of 5 years.
- 4.5 Age relaxation to the candidates who have Course Completed Act Apprentices for Level-I.

5. EXAMINATION FEE

5.1 Fee payable:-

While applying the candidates claiming fee exemption must Submit necessary certificate i.e. SC/ST/OBC/minorities/EBC/PwBD in the forms prescribed.

* Minorities mean Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists, Zoroastrian (Parsis) and Jains.

** Economically Backward candidate means those whose annual family income is less than Rs. 50,000/-

*** Persons with disability –Only those candidates would be eligible for reservation in services/posts who suffer from not less than 40 percent of relevant disability.



Separate application with separate examination fee shall be submitted in case of candidate applying for both the Level-2 and Level-1 posts.

The Examination fee is payable only in form of Indian Postal Order (IPO) drawn in favour of 'Assistant Personnel Officer (Recruitment), Railway Recruitment Cell, North Western Railway, payable at Jaipur. (Examination Fee is not refundable / transferable /adjustable under any circumstances even rejection of candidature, except candidates mentioned above in para 5.1.)

- 5.4 IPOs issued before the opening date will not be accepted and Application Form is liable to be rejected.
- 5.5 Application received with Cash / Cheque / Money order /DD/ Central Recruitment Fee Stamps will not be accepted and application form will be rejected.
- 5.6 Candidates must write their name, full address at the space provided in the IPO.
- 5.7 Application not accompanied by Indian Postal Order of requisite amount for examination fee, wherever required, will be summarily rejected.
- 5.8 For claiming waiver of Examination fees, Minority candidates should furnish 'self declaration' as mentioned in Annexure-7 along with affidavit (non-judicial stamp paper) with Application Form. **If the affidavit is not attached with the application form, their candidature will be rejected & Examination Fees will not be refunded.**
- 5.9 For claiming waiver of Examination fees, Economically Backward candidates have to attach income certificate with the application form in the prescribed format as given in Annexure-5 on the letter head of the issuing authority with their seal/stamp.
- 5.10 **Authorities competent to issue income certificates:-**
- District Magistrate or any other Revenue Officer up to the level of the Tehsildar.
 - Sitting Member of Parliament of Lok Sabha for persons of their own constituency.
 - Below Poverty Line (BPL) Card or any other certificate issued by Central Government under a recognized poverty alleviation programme or Izzat MST issued by Railways.
 - Union Minister may also recommend any person from anywhere in the country.
 - Sitting Member of Parliament of Rajya Sabha for persons of the district in which these MPs normally reside.
- 5.11 For claiming fee exemption candidates should submit their Account No. & IFSC Code, Name of Bank & branch Name in the space provided in the application form.

6. Community Certificate:-

- 6.1 **The posts against Scout & Guide quota are open to all categories and candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC categories who apply against Scout & Guide quota will be extended relaxation in age limit as admissible in general open market recruitment and selected candidates will be taken against reserved & roster point.**
- 6.2 Candidates claiming to belongs to SC/ST & OBC communities are required to produce community certificates from the competent Authority in the prescribed format (prescribed for Central Government employment) as per Annexure – 2 & 3 respectively and enclose the self attested photocopy of the same with the application.
- 6.3 The Community Certificate produced by OBC candidates should specifically indicate that the candidate does not belong to Creamy layer and certificate should have been issued in financial year.



NOC for Serving Employees:-

Candidates serving in any Centre/State Government Department including Railways or Public Sector Undertaking should apply through proper channel or should apply directly to the RRC with NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE from the employer to avoid delay. The last date of receipt of applications in the office of Railway Recruitment Cell will not be extended on account of any delay in transmitting the application by the office concerned. Advance copy of the application without No Objection Certificate will not be entertained. Applications received after closing date and time will also not be accepted.

8. General Instructions:-

- 8.1 Before applying for any level, the candidates should ensure that he/she fulfils all the eligibility norms. The candidates should have the requisite Educational/Technical qualifications from the recognized board/NCVT as on the date of submission of the application. Those awaiting results of the final exams need not apply. RRC may reject the application of candidates at any stage of recruitment process in case the candidates are not fulfilling the requisite criteria. if appointed, such candidates are liable to be removed from service summarily.
- 8.2 Candidates who have been debarred for life from all RRB/RRC examinations or candidates who have been debarred for a specified period which is not yet completed need not apply in response to this employment notice. Their candidature will be rejected during any stage of recruitment as and when detected. if appointed, such candidates are liable to be removed from service summarily.
- 8.3 Candidates should fill up the Application Form in their own handwriting and must sign as well as put their Left Thumb Impression in the prescribed space. Applications should be filled either in English or in Hindi.
- 8.4 Applications should be on a good quality A4 size bond paper using one side only. Candidates purchasing printed Application Forms from the market should ensure that it conforms to the prescribed format published in this Employment Notice. Application Form & Annexures can also be downloaded from the website www.rrcjaipur.in & www.nwr.indianrailways.gov.in. Employment notice is also displayed on the notice board in the office of RRC/North Western Railway/Jaipur.
- 8.5 Candidates should send their application sufficiently in advance of the closing date. Applications received beyond the last date will not be entertained. Railway Recruitment Cell, North Western Railway will not be responsible for any postal delay/wrong delivery whatsoever at any stage of the selection process.
- 8.6 Candidate are required to sign in English/Hindi at the prescribed place provided in the Application Form. Signatures on Application Form, Answer Sheet, Question Booklet and other places should be identical and must be in running hand and not in Block/Capital or Disjointed letters (if signed in English). Signatures in different style or language, at the time of application, written examination and documents verification, may result in cancellation of candidature.
- 8.7 Selection by RRC does not confer upon candidate any right of Appointment in the Railway.



- Selected candidates will have to undergo training wherever training is prescribed for the post.
- 8.9 Emoluments on initial appointment will be minimum pay of the Level, plus other allowances admissible at that time. During training period only stipend will be paid as applicable. Candidates may have to give security deposit and execute indemnity bond wherever necessary.
- 8.10 Free Second Class Railway Pass as admissible will be issued to candidates belonging to SC/ST communities when they are called for Written Examination/ Document Verification, provided they submit valid caste certificate.
- 8.11 Selected male candidates who are finally appointed are liable for active service in Railway Engineers 'Unit of Territorial Army'.
- 8.12 Any subsequent changes in the terms and conditions of the Employment Notice as per extant rules will stand good. RRC reserves the right to consider/incorporate any subsequent changes/ modification/ additions/ cancellation in the terms & conditions to recruitment under this Employment Notice as and when applicable.
- 8.13 **No column in the application should be left blank as that may lead to rejection of the application. N.A. (not applicable) should be written in those Column/Columns which do not apply to the candidate.**
- 8.14 Verification of all testimonials and certificates will also be a mandatory condition for appointment. Candidates are required to produce original documents at the time of document verification.
- 8.15 In case candidates are selected for Clerical category, they shall have to pass the proficiency in Typing with minimum speed of 30 w.p.m in English or 25 w.p.m in Hindi, within a period of 02 years from the date of appointment, for which they may get maximum three chances only, no additional time will be given and failing which service of such candidates will be summarily terminated.
- 8.16 The date, venue and time of the Written Examination will be published on our website www.rrejaipur.in & www.nwr.indianrailways.gov.in. The decision of North Western Railway in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of application and allotment of venues will be final and binding on the candidates.
- 8.17 The candidates are liable to be called at short notice for various stages of the examination.

9. Enclosures (should be self attested) :-

Procedure for Recruitment for Scouts & Guides quota (FOR BOTH LEVELS):

The candidates, who apply in response to the notification and are found eligible for consideration for appointment against Scouts & Guides quota, will be assessed on the basis of following criteria.

	The Written Test will consist of 40 objective questions (40 Marks) & 1 essay type question (20 Marks) relating to Scouts and Guides Organization and its activities and General Knowledge for Level-2 and Level-1. The Syllabus for this will be as per para 12. There will be negative marking in the written test and 1/3 rd of marks allotted for the objective type Question will be deducted for every wrong answer. Written test shall be of duration of 60 minutes. Question paper will be bi-lingual (Hindi & English). Candidates can attempt written examination in Hindi or English.

13. Medical Fitness :-

Candidates recommended for appointment will have to pass requisite medical examination in the prescribed medical standard by Railway medical Authority to ensure that the candidates



are medically fit to carry out the duties connected with the post. Visual Acuity Standard is one of the important criteria of medical fitness of Railway Staff.

15. Whom To Apply:-

The application should be sent along with required documents by Ordinary Post (Courier post/Registered post/Speed post will not be accepted) to Assistant Personnel Officer (Recruitment), Railway Recruitment Cell, North Western Railway, Power House Road, Opp. DRM Office, Jaipur – 302006 or dropped in the Box kept in the office, RRC, Jaipur for this purpose.

The envelope containing the application duly complete in all respects must be super-scribed "Application for Scouts and Guides Quota, 2022-23 (Level- 2) OR (Level-1)" for which the candidate is applying.

Note:- Candidates if eligible may apply for both posts i.e Level-2 and Level-1 . Candidates should note that separate applications with separate fee will have to be submitted for each Level-2 and Level-1.

16. How to Apply:-

- 16.1 First-of-all candidates must carefully read/ go through all the instruction given in this notification and follow the same.
- 16.2 The application form as per Annexure 1 should be filled up by the candidate in his/her own handwriting, with blue or black ball point pen (not in pencil, fountain pen or gel pen) duly dated, signed & with thumb impression.. The Application Form should be filled up in English or in Hindi only,(international numbers i.e, 1,2,3 etc. should be used) strictly observing all the instructions given in the Employment Notice. Candidates should affix their normal signature in English (not in capital letters) or in Hindi in the Application Form. Application signed in capital letters (in English)/spaced out letters will be treated as invalid and will be rejected.
- 16.3 **Candidate's Name, Address with Pin Code, Date of Birth, Father's Name and nearest Railway Station should be written legibly in English in bold capital letters, even if the candidate fills up the Application Form in Hindi.**
- 16.4 Photographs : One recent(not earlier than three months from the date of application) colour photographs of size 3.5x3.5 c.m. with clear front view of the candidate without cap (Scouts & Guide uniform's cap is also not allowed) and sunglasses, should be pasted on the Application Form in the space provided. 

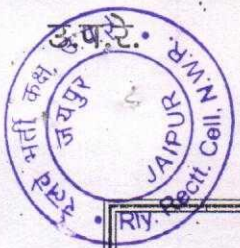
